# DO...

- wear protective gloves when handling used oil
- change your oil in a well ventilated area
- pour your used oil into a clean container with a secure screw lid
- take your oil to your nearest used oil recycling facility as soon as possible

# DON'T...

- store used oil in containers that once contained chemicals, paint or other vehicle fluids (they contain residues that may contaminate the oil)
- leave the used oil lying in the shed for a long period of time (it is a dangerous fire hazard and increases the risk of an oil leak)
- change oil in a rush (it increases the chances of an accidental spill)
- inappropriately dispose of your used oil\*
